Opening: "Thomas Kovachevich: 2013" at Callicoon

The first two parts of a Thomas Kovachevich trinity open this evening at Callicoon's Forsyth space and its brand-new one on Delancey. (Part three hits Show Room in Gowanus on Feb. 28.) Mr. Kovachevich, who will present work made in the last year, is a master of sculptures and installations that use the humblest of materials (a bit of plastic, maybe some tape) to create bewitching visual effects. Sometimes they're designed to subtly change with their environment, which is when things get really interesting. It's hard to explain, but easy to love, and not to be missed.
